



- ❖ The RE/Worship overview continually reinforces the British value-'Tolerance of those of different faiths and beliefs'. Each term we have a Christian value worship focus with is chosen to reflect current global, school or community event,
- ❖ The chosen Christian worship value also provides the opportunity to enhance the children's understanding of a British and School game value in greater depth as we make relevant and robust connections and links through whole school worship, school value days and class teaching.

Each chosen value promotes the Christian value of Koinonia, this is demonstrated through our strong and vibrant links with St.Barnabas Church and our wider school community. *Koinonia is a Greek word that occurs 20 times in the Bible. Koinonia's primary meaning is "fellowship, sharing in common, communion." The first occurrence of koinonia is Acts 2:42, "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer."*
Christian fellowship is a key aspect of the Christian life. Believers in Christ are to come together in love, faith, and encouragement. That is the essence of koinonia.
