



Safeguarding at St Barnabas CE Primary School.

1. Safeguarding is the responsibility of everyone in school, this means YOU as well.
2. If you see anything that makes you feel worried about a child's welfare please inform the Head Teacher or a member of staff.
3. If a child tells you anything that makes you feel they may be unsafe in any way tell the teacher or Head Teacher.
4. Do not ask questions of the child and do not investigate yourself, we have people specially trained to deal with these situations.
5. All visitors into school are responsible for their conduct and are asked to read and sign the schools Code of Conduct.
6. Mrs J Fisher is the Designated Senior Person for Safeguarding. Miss J Hodgkinson and Miss E Perkins are the other members of the Safeguarding team based in school.

Whistleblowing

1. Whistleblowing means telling someone if you see an adult in school do or say something to a child or member of staff that makes you worried.
2. If you witness an action by an adult in school that worries you tell Miss Hodgkinson immediately.
3. If you have a safeguarding concern about the Head teacher then ask to speak to the Chair of Governors about your concern.
4. These concerns will be taken very seriously and can be reported to the LADO (Local Authority Designated Officer) who is the person who will investigate any concerns reported.
